

Certified Home Performance Advisor training programme (Level 2)

Page 1: Background Information

The Home Performance Advisor training programme is a pathway for practitioners to become highly competent and effective advisors.

Certification helps New Zealanders know who to trust for high quality, independent, personalised advice to help them improve the performance of their homes and their quality of life. It also allows certified advisors to demonstrate their competency and professional standards.

The Home Performance Advisor training programme has been developed by a group of not-for-profit organisations through a collaborative initiative¹. The training reflects the core principles of the Practitioners' Hub and an agreed approach to providing advice.

Our core principles

Advice must be:

1. Independent;
2. Based on good science and best practice; and
3. Personalised and in the best interests of the client.

Our Approach

Advice should be provided on the basis of:

1. Assessment - An assessment of the house informed by a comprehensive understanding of the science of home performance, best practice and a consultation with the occupants²;
2. Diagnosis - Diagnosis of the underlying cause or causes of problems in the house and identification of actions to address the causes; and
3. Recommendations – Prioritised recommended actions to address the underlying causes of the problems in the first instance³, which meet the needs of the client and their personal circumstances⁴.

Therefore advice must not be driven by an advisors interest in selling a predetermined product or service. However good advice does not exclude recommendations of products and services where, based on an assessment of the situation, an advisor considers they will address the underlying causes of problems in a house in the first instance, and meet the needs and preferences of the client. Home Performance Advisors are required to comply with a Code of Conduct that reflects these core principles and approach.

¹ The key partners are Beacon Pathway Incorporated, Community Energy Network and Toimata Foundation. Beacon administers the joint project on behalf of the partners

² An assessment may be provided in the home or by other appropriate means, such as over the telephone, but must include a comprehensive assessment of the house and clients in question.

³ Recommendations should follow a hierarch whereby they address the underlying causes of a problem in the first instance and manage or mitigate where that is not possible.

⁴ This should take into account what the client can afford and the client's personal preferences or needs.

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Page 2: Registration information

Eligibility for the course

To be eligible for the Home Performance Advisor programme a candidate must meet the following pre-requisites and be able to demonstrate that they subscribe to the core principles and approach above, and will reflect its intent in their practice. To be eligible for the course, you must:

- i. Have passed the 'Home Energy Awareness' (level 1) course (85% pass rate)
- ii. Be able to demonstrate that the business model you work with is based around providing clients with independent advice guided by a balanced assessment of the house and recommendations of actions that are appropriate in the situation,
- iii. Confirm that you are prepared to comply with the Code of Conduct if you pass the course and seek certification, ([see separate document](#))
- iv. Confirm that you are prepared to meet the requirements for on-going certification and professional development, ([see separate document](#))

Note that the HPA registrar reserves the right to decline entry to the course if the applicant cannot adequately demonstrate they meet these eligibility criteria.

2020 Course fees

These tables specify the fees for this training course. The fee covers all course materials, accommodation and food for the 2.5 day course.

It is a requirement of the course that you stay 'in residence' for its duration.
